NOTE: UNICEF is one of the largest organizations in the world, and it is impossible to keep track of all of its activities. This document is a mere sample of what it does around the world.

The decapitation hook, protected by the palm of the left hand, is passed up over the child's shoulder and turned over the neck. If the hook is sharp, the neck is severed by sawing movement and if it is blunt, rotate it to cause fracture dislocation of the cervical spines then the soft tissue is cut by an embryotomy scissors with a blunt tip. The trunk is delivered first by traction on the arm. The head is then delivered by hooking a finger into the mouth or with a forceps.¹

General Information on UNICEF

The **United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF)** was formerly known as the **United Nations International Children's Emergency Fund (UNICEF)**. It is a monstrous \$5 billion-a-year organ of the United Nations. Certainly the majority of its activities are laudable, but it has been caught up in the population control mentality of its parent organization, the United Nations, and pushes abortion and "family planning" in many nations. Support of Criminal and Immoral Activities by UNICEF

The United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF) supports the following activities, which are illegal or criminal acts in many of the countries it operates in.

- **Euthanasia for Children:** During Canada's debate over its C-14 euthanasia bill in 2016, UNICEF spoke out about the "rights" of children, stating that excluding them from having the "right to euthanasia" would be discriminatory. These killings, of course, would be done without parental knowledge or consent, and UNICEF did not specify a lower age limit at which a child could request euthanasia. - **Homosexual Pederasty:** UNICEF was part of an interdisciplinary team led by the United Nations World Health Organization that published a 2015 Technical Brief entitled "[HIV and Young Men Who have Sex with Men](#)." Under the section on definition of terms, it

defines "Young men who have sex with men" as "males 10-24 years, including boys 10-17 and men 18-24 who have sex with other males." his technical brief acknowledges that adolescent males (ages 10-17) face grave dangers to their lives and health by engaging in sex at such young ages, but does not recommend any kind of action designed to protect them from predatory adult homosexual men other than recommending the decriminalization of prostitution and drug use for these boys as young as ten years old. In fact, the document, as do all of its type, states that the main dangers to young homosexual boys is "homophobia — manifested in discrimination, bullying, harassment, family disapproval, social isolation and violence — as well as criminalization and self-stigmatization." It also refuses to address the predatory nature of many homosexual men, who refer to such children as "chickens" and to themselves as "chicken hawks." It only has a coy little footnote in tiny print that says "This technical brief does not address sexual abuse of children." It is well-known that homosexual men see sex with adolescent males as especially desirable. Thus, taken as a whole, it is reasonable to conclude that this document tacitly approves of the sexual molestation of young boys by homosexual men. - **Transgenderism and Same-Sex "Marriage:"** In November 2014, UNICEF published a position paper entitled "[Eliminating Discrimination against Children and Parents based on Sexual Orientation and/or Gender Identity](#)." This document seeks to normalize transgenderism and all other homosexual activity, including same-sex "marriage," and calls for respect for LGBT people while not pointing out that many of their practices are deadly and

UNICEF also agitates for "transgender rights" in many nations. For example, in Bangladesh, "UNICEF provided assistance to the Government to ensure the recognition of and protection for the rights of transgenders as a third gender. The Government can now guide the creation of laws, policies and socio-cultural practices towards individuals with different sexual orientation and gender identity. This will allow for greater inclusion of key affected populations and enable transgenders to access services, especially reproductive health services."²

- **Homosexuality and Masturbation:** UNICEF funds a South African teen Web site called LoveLife, which encourages children from ten years old and up to masturbate (the Web site says "start practicing!"), to use contraception, to have abortions without parental consent (the Web site says "You don't need permission from anybody to have an abortion"), and encourages children to try homosexuality and bisexuality (the Web site says "Some people prefer not to limit their horny feelings to only half the population. They'll fall in love with whoever feels right — male or female. Why let body parts limit the power of love?! ... Most people fall in love with someone of the same sex at least once in their lives..."). The Web site also instructs young children in sexual foreplay (the Web site says "After, you could always share your special tricks with us!"). - **Forcing Homosexuality on the Schools:** UNICEF signed the Mexico City Ministerial Declaration “Educating to Prevent: Addressing Homophobia in Schools,” which was written by the Sexuality Information and Educational Council of the United States (SIECUS). The “Ministerial Declaration” is a document that demands full “sexual and reproductive health rights” for adolescents, to include comprehensive sex education (remember that the definition of “adolescent” includes children of ten years of age, and that “reproductive health” is a deceptive term that always includes abortion).³ These objectives would be achieved by national Ministers of Health and the Ministers of Education working together and sharing resources.

Not surprisingly, this document also calls for the systematic repression of all questioning of the homosexual agenda in schools, automatically labeling all opposition as “homophobia.” It calls for severe punishment of all of those students who are “homophobic” in any way. Thus, free speech is chilled, which is the document’s entire purpose. Of course, the document does not address any other kind of bullying in any way, seeing them as unimportant and insignificant.

According to the “Ministerial Declaration,”

The Mexico City Ministerial Declaration represents a partnership between Ministries of Education and Ministries of Health, marked by the establishment of joint planning, implementation, monitoring, evaluation and follow up, as well as facilitating involvement of other key sectors. It represents a synergy between Ministries of Health and Ministers of Education to develop and deliver the

information, education and counseling needed to reverse the HIV/AIDS epidemic, promote healthy lifestyles through comprehensive sexuality education as well as sexual health related services.

- **Prostitution:** A high UNICEF official called for the legalization of prostitution and for UNICEF to make condoms available "for everybody, everywhere and at all times." Urban Jonsson, UNICEF Eastern and Southern African Regional Director, said "Let us stop the almost metaphysical debate on the pros and cons of the use of condoms. Let us follow the decision of the government of Botswana to make condoms available and accessible for everybody, everywhere and at all times. The use of condoms is not the full or the final solution, but it has been a part of all known successes to reduce HIV infections. - **Abortion:** As long ago as 1987, UNICEF officially endorsed "good quality abortion services" at the International Conference on Better Health for Women and Children in Nairobi, Kenya. UNICEF also partnered with the United Nations World Health Organization (UNWHO) and the UN Fund for Population Activities (UNFPA) in the Coordinating Committee on Health, with UNFPA's major partner agency, the International Planned Parenthood Federation (IPPF), the largest abortion-pushing organization in the world. America-based international abortion promoter IPAS advised potential clients its "manual vacuum aspirators" (for village abortions) are supplied by the UNICEF *Warehouse Catalogue*. - **Abortion for Refugee Children:** Like all population control and pro-abortion groups, UNICEF wastes no crisis, using each one to promote abortion as vigorously as possible. To this end, one of its many pro-abortion manuals, entitled "Reproductive Health in Refugee Situations: An Interagency Field Manual," promotes abortion and contraception for girls as young as ten years old. - **China's Forced Abortion Program:** In 1993, UNICEF boosted its contribution to UNFPA's open support for China's "one-child family" policy — Beijing's program to shrink its population with coerced sterilizations, late-term abortions and sometimes infanticide — from \$2 million to \$5 million. Incredibly, in its 1997 *State of the World's Children* report, UNICEF praised China as the most "baby-friendly" nation in the world, despite widely distributed video documentation of "dying rooms" of starving babies in Chinese orphanages and widespread child labor. - **Sex with Animals (Bestiality):** UNICEF distributed a sex education manual in Latin America that endorses abortion, homosexuality and sex with inanimate objects and animals. The manual says that "Here we should insist that there is no ideal or perfect relationship between two or several people; (just) the one that gives us the most

The book, entitled "Theoretic Elements for Working with Mothers and Pregnant Teens," says "Situations in which you can obtain sexual pleasure: 1. Masturbation. 2. Sexual relations with a partner — whether heterosexual, homosexual, or bisexual. 3. A sexual response that is directed toward inanimate objects, animals, minors, non-consenting persons."⁴

- **Abortifacients in Vaccines:** UNICEF will go to any despicable lengths to control and suppress the fertility of women in developing countries. In 1995, the Catholic Women's League of the Philippines won a court order halting a UNICEF anti-tetanus program because the vaccine had been laced with B-hCG, a hormone that sterilizes and causes miscarriages in its recipients. The Supreme Court of the Philippines found the surreptitious sterilization program had already vaccinated three million women, aged 12 to 45. - **Population Control:** UNICEF is not at all concerned about the customs, cultures or laws of the nations it operates in. In her short book *UNICEF: Guilty as Charged* (1996), Canadian geographer Winifride Prestwich of Toronto's Havergal College, details UNICEF's gradual embrace of the population control and sexual liberation ideology. Some examples of UNICEF's activities: as long ago as 1987, UNICEF, in partnership with the United Nations Fund for Population Activities (UNFPA), spent \$720,684 to purchase abortifacient contraceptives in [Jamaica](#); contributed \$700,000 to a World Bank project that established 18 sterilization facilities in [Kenya](#);

contributed \$1,800,000 to another United Nations World Bank project in [Malawi](#) for the development of sterilization services; financed for \$795,569 an UNFPA and United Nations World Health Organization (UNWHO) project that expanded mobile sterilization units in [Nepal](#); funded for \$37,116 a UNFPA project in [Rwanda](#) that supplied abortifacients; funded for \$21,657 another UNFPA project in conjunction with the International Planned Parenthood Federation (IPPF) in [Tanzania](#) that provided a wide range of abortifacients; funded a stockpile of contraceptives in [Zimbabwe](#); and sponsored the formation of committees in 15 African nations to expand contraception, abortion and sterilization, and attack indigenous family values [United Nations Population Fund. *Inventory of Population Projects in Developing Countries around the World, 1987-1988* (15th Edition), May 1989. - **Contraception:** UNICEF helps organizations like DKT International supply gigantic amounts of contraceptives all over the developing world, including hundreds of millions of condoms, which have proven to be ineffective at stopping the HIV/AIDS epidemic. For example, in 2012 alone, UNICEF assisted DKT in distributing hundreds of millions of condoms, IUDs, doses of abortifacient injectables, implants and emergency contraception (EC) in the nations of DR Congo, Ethiopia, Myanmar and Romania [DKT's annual [Contraceptive Social Marketing Statistics Report](#)]. - **Corruption:** The United Nations has a free ride with mandatory donations from many developed nations. Therefore, it feels that it has little accountability to these donors. A 2012 report found that

UNICEF and UNFPA had billions of dollars of surplus cash, and could not account for hundreds of millions of dollars of it. UNICEF refused to answer questions after failing this audit and, despite constantly claiming that it is dedicated to "transparency," refused to disclose details of wages, salaries, travel, consultant costs, and other items. - **Coercion and Suppressing Conscience Rights:** The [United Nations Human Reproduction Program \(UNHRP\)](#) consists of member agencies the United Nations World Health Organization, the United Nations Population Fund (UNFPA), the United Nations Development Program (UNDP), UNICEF, and the United Nations World Bank. In 2015, the UNHRP published "[Sexual Health, Human Rights and the Law](#)," which is basically a call for worldwide legalized abortion. But this document goes much further; in Section, 3.2.2., "[Conscientious Objection by Health-Care Providers](#)," these UN agencies state that "the health-care professional who objects must provide safe services to save an individual's life or to prevent damage to her health." Since the World Health Organization defines "health" as "A state of complete physical, mental, and social well-being and not merely the absence of disease or infirmity," this is a direct statement that all medical personnel should be forced to perform abortions over their religious or other objections. Activities by UNICEF

- (1) The 2005 *Millennium Project Report*, signed by UNICEF, says that "The Task Force opposes the political ideologies and religious fundamentalisms that have sought to erode women's reproductive rights guaranteed through numerous international conventions." - (2) Interestingly, UNICEF has never tried to hide its activism in pushing anti-life and anti-family agendas. One example of this boldness (perhaps brought on by a feeling of invincibility stemming from being a major player in the United Nations) is a set of 1994 papers entitled "[Influencing Public Policy](#)." Two of these papers are entitled "Lessons Learned: Making Summits Work," by UNICEF, which "describes strategies for implementing goals, including identification of the do-able, political commitment, mobilization of a much wider range of social resources, and deployment of the expertise and resources of the United Nations (UN)." Another paper is "The United Nations and the Nongovernmental Organizations," which "discusses the role NGOs play in the work of the UN." - (3) UNICEF is listed as a "[United Nations Organization Providing Population Assistance](#)" by Population Action International (PAI) (formerly the Population Crisis Committee) in a 1995 list that describes the organizations listed as "organizations involved in international population work." It was also listed in the United Nations Population Fund (UNFPA) *Guide to Sources of International Population Assistance 1993* (eighth edition) [New York City: United Nations], 1993.

- (4) UNICEF is a member of the [Inter-Agency Working Group on Reproductive Health in Crises \(IAWG\)](#), whose purpose is “to uphold and realize the right to reproductive health for all women, men and adolescents in humanitarian settings.” “Adolescents” has been defined by the United Nations as children ten years old and older. - (5) UNICEF signed a September 2015 resolution entitled “[Ending Violence and Discrimination against Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender and Intersex People](#).” This resolution, which was signed by most of the major organs of the United Nations, is a formal, full-on endorsement of all aspects of the homosexual special rights agenda. It makes the false claim that millions of homosexuals and other “sexual minorities” face grave threats against their most basic human rights, and asserts that failure to uphold their rights “constitute[s] serious violations of international human rights law.” The document calls for enhanced prosecution of people who commit hate crimes against LGBTI individuals and condemns what it calls “unethical and harmful so-called “therapies” to change sexual orientation.” The document also demands special rights for transgendered people and “education” of others about their special needs and says that LGBTI people should help draft laws that concern them. Most of this sounds very reasonable, but in places where such policies have been enacted, immediate repression of “homophobes” immediately begins, to include systematic violation of the rights of those who oppose the homosexual agenda. - (6) UNICEF is a member organization of the [Maternal Health Task Force \(MHTF\)](#), which was based at EngenderHealth from 2008 to 2011 and is currently heavily funded by the Gates, MacArthur and Hansen Family Foundations. It consists of a conglomeration of about seventy non-governmental organizations (NGOs). Most of these groups are either single-purpose population suppression groups or heavily involved in promoting "reproductive health" and "family planning," including abortion, all over the world. Although the MHTF does address all of the major causes of maternal mortality, its primary emphasis is obviously to spread surgical and chemical abortion in the developing world. It has funded and supported such extreme pro-abortion and population control organizations as Marie Stopes International (which boasts that it does illegal abortions all over the world), the Center for Reproductive Rights (CRR), the Guttmacher Institute, Gynuity Health Projects, the Population Council, Population Action International (PAI), and the United Nations Population Fund (UNFPA), which helped to develop and operate the Chinese forced abortion program. - (7) In conjunction with some of the most strident population control groups in the world (UNFPA, WHO, UNICEF, Population Services International (PSI) and Save the Children), as well as Liberia's Ministry of Health and Social Welfare (MOHSW), UNICEF drew up a ["Sexual and Reproductive Health Policy for the Republic of Liberia,"](#) which includes all of the policies that have failed all over

the rest of Africa. As we all know by now, the blanket term "sexual and reproductive health" includes free abortion through all nine months of pregnancy for any reason at all, sterilization, all forms of birth control (to include the abortifacient hormonal methods), sterilization, and invasive comprehensive sex education designed to condition school children to abandon the values of their nation, their culture, their faith and their families. The sponsoring organizations were International Planned Parenthood Federation (IPPF), the Population Council, the United Nations International Children's Emergency Fund (UNICEF), the United Nations Development Program (UNDP), the United Nations Fund for Population Activities (UNFPA), the United Nations World Bank (UNWB), and the United Nations World Health Organization (UNWHO). Integrating Abortion with Other Services: UNICEF, like other pro-abortion groups, is cleverly mashing together all different types of services in order to protect abortion and population control. UNICEF, working together with three other United Nations agencies (the World Health Organization, the United Nations Population Fund, and UNAIDS), published a guide called "[Asia and Pacific Regional Framework for Integrating Prevention and Management of STIs and HIV Infection with Reproductive, Maternal and Newborn Health Services](#)." This is not done just for the sake of efficiency; UNICEF believes that it can protect population control by giving the impression that it MUST be integrated with lifesaving services, otherwise the entire package will be meaningless. Country Reports — Africa: With its gigantic budget, UNICEF does a tremendous amount of good work all around the world. However, like

many other groups, it uses its good works to deflect criticism from the terrible damage it does. UNICEF is deeply involved with population control, especially the distribution of contraceptives, with an emphasis on the use of condoms (ignoring the fact that, since condoms fail one time in fourteen uses, the African nations that use the most condoms also have the highest adult HIV/AIDS infection rates). RH Plan for Africa: In June 2003, African heads of state met in Maputo to formulate a "[Plan of Action on the Family in Africa](#)," whose purpose "is to advocate for the promotion, formulation, implementation and monitoring of policies and programmes to ensure the protection of and support to the African family so as to enable it play its vital role more effectively in the development of Africa." UNICEF was a primary partner in this effort. Paragraphs 54 and 55 of this "Plan of Action" deal with reproductive health, and assert that "Member states should promote Sexual and Reproductive Health as fundamental human rights; Ensure the integration of sexual and reproductive health services into the NEPAD framework; Assist families in need to access family planning services; Establish appropriate mechanisms to respond to the special issues of adolescent sexual and reproductive health; Integrate sexual and reproductive health and life skills training into the school curricula and establish adolescent-friendly services." Sex Education: UNICEF was listed as a participant in the updating of the Second Edition of UNESCO's [International Technical Guidance on Sexuality Education: An Evidence-Informed Approach for Schools, Teachers and Health Educators](#) in 2018 in support of the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). Major contributors to the First and Second Editions of the [International Technical Guidance](#) included some of the worst population suppression organizations on Earth, including the International Planned Parenthood Federation (IPPF), the Planned Parenthood Federation of America (PPFA), SIECUS and the United Nations Population Fund (UNFPA), which has been deeply involved in the Chinese forced abortion program for decades. The result, of course, could not be anything but an "everything goes" approach that is entirely bereft of moral guidance. Apparently, "evidence-informed" means to studiously ignore any evidence that contradicts the writers of this *Guidance*, since not one pro-life or pro-family person or organization was consulted. This *Guidance* recommends that sex education begin at the age of five, and that it feature all of the elements of explicit sex education, including the use of abortion and all methods of contraception, and the acceptance of all sexual practices, no matter how harmful or bizarre. The William and Flora Hewlett Foundation hosted the conference that contributed to the writing of the original *Guidance*, and the primary authors were from the Sexuality Information and Education Council of the United States (SIECUS) and ETR (Education, Training, Research) Associates. Contraception and Abortion for 10-Year-Old Girls: In 2007, the Population Council, the United Nations Population Fund (UNFPA), UNICEF and the United Nations Joint Program on AIDS (UNAIDS) cooperated to publish "[Investing When It Counts: Generating the Evidence Base for Policies and Programs for Very Young Adolescents — Guide and Tool Kit.](#)" Right at the beginning, the document defines "very young adolescents" as "children aged 10-14." The entire focus of this publication is beginning and implementing "reproductive health" for these young children, including explicit sex education, condom use and prevention of HIV/AIDS. Abstinence, on the other hand, is barely mentioned at all, and the words "mother," "father" and "parent" appear only as elements in survey questions. The "Tool Kit" asserts that "Condom provision should be strengthened" among girls from 10 to 14 years old, that people should not judge them for having sex at such a young age, and that one of the factors that interfere with such young people's rights is the "illegality of abortion." All of this and much more is contained in their publication designed to increase "reproductive health" use by very young girls, thus exposing them to exploitation and much worse. Contraception and Abortion for 10-Year-Old Girls: One gets the feeling that UNICEF churns out huge and complicated documents on children without consulting with any actual children. After all, who but an ivory-tower UN bureaucrat could imagine a little ten-year-old girl demanding condoms or the right to abortion? One good example of this

is the 110-page "[A World Fit for Children: Millennium Development Goals Special Session on Children Documents the Convention on the Rights of the Child.](#)" The "Declaration" says that "We will promote gender equality and equal access to basic social services, such as education, nutrition, health care, including sexual and reproductive health care, vaccinations, and protection from diseases representing the major causes of mortality, and will mainstream a gender perspective in all development policies and programs," [paragraph 23] which means, of course, imposing the Western model of feminism on all developing nations. Paragraph 36(g) demands "Access through the primary health-care system to reproductive health for all individuals of appropriate ages as soon as possible and no later than 2015" (keep in mind that this includes girls as young as age 10 as specified in many other UNICEF documents). Contraception and Abortion for 10-Year-Old Girls: The members of the United Nations Adolescent Girls Task Force are the United Nations International Labor Organization (UNILO), the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO), the United Nations Population Fund (UNFPA), the United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF), the United Nations Development Fund for Women (UNIFEM), and the United Nations World Health Organization (UNWHO). In March 2010, the Directors General or Executive Directors of all six of these organizations signed "[Accelerating Efforts to Advance the Rights of Adolescent Girls: A UN Joint Statement.](#)" This statement says that its

purpose is to "empower the hardest-to-reach adolescent girls, particularly those aged 10 to 14 years." One of the "five strategic priorities" mentioned by this Statement is "Ensure adolescent girls' access to age-appropriate health and nutrition information and services, including life skills-based sexuality education, HIV prevention, and sexual and reproductive health." It is widely understood that "reproductive health" includes contraception and abortion. Condoms for Children: UNICEF works in almost all developing nations to "program" youth to "exercise their rights to survival and health by making informed and responsible decisions on sexual and reproductive health." Most of the time, these decisions involve the distribution of condoms and other contraceptives by UNICEF. UNICEF's publication "[Working for and with Adolescents — Some UNICEF Examples](#)," shows the details on many of the group's activities with young people, and is an important document to read if you want to know how UNICEF reaches and corrupts children. Comic Books Promoted by UNICEF



[PCI Media Impact](#) distributes a series of comic books in cooperation with UNICEF and Stan Lee of Marvel Comics fame. The series was founded by "Thought Leader" Maria Snyder (a title she is apparently proud of; but it kind of sounds pretty Orwellian).

The "hero" of the series is an Indian boy named Raju Rai, who

lives in Mumbai and takes on a part-time job assisting the eccentric and strange scientist, Dr. Singh. Raju puts on a highly experimental prototype suit created by Dr. Singh that is designed to activate the points of energy in the body called chakras, giving Raju amazing superpowers and turning him into Mumbai's superhero protector — **CHAKRA THE INVINCIBLE!**

Well ... at least the kid didn't have to get bitten by a spider to get his superpowers.

- (1) The "[Heroes for Change](#)" comic book is an introduction to the series that urges kids to get organized and learn about the seventeen Goals for Sustainable Development, and then to "evangelize" everyone they know;

- (3) The "[Gender Equality](#)" comic book, which has several goals for kids to strive for, including "Protect[ing] women's rights to sexual and reproductive health;"
- (4) The "[Education](#)" comic book, which urges kids to demand their right to a good education, and shows ways to get children out of the grip of child labor; and

including UNICEF, UNESCO, ActionAid International, Comic Relief, the International Red Cross and Red Crescent Federation, PCI Media Impact, Oxfam, PLAN, Save the Children, and World Vision.
